The following behaviour will **NOT** be tolerated at Manly Campus:

- Dangerous or violent behaviour.
- Disruption of the work of teachers and students.
- Possession of dangerous implements or weapons or imitation weapons.
- Possession or use of illegal drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
- Disobedience.
- Truancy and unexplained absences.
- Vandalism.
- Stealing.
- Misuse of the I.T. or internet facilities.
- Offensive or abusive language.
- All forms of harassments and discrimination against students and staff.

Students are advised not to bring valuables or a sum of money greater than \$10. If larger amounts are brought for such reason as excursions, please pay at the Cashier's office before school.

Mobile phones are to be turned off during class time. Built in camera devices are not permitted to be used at anytime on school grounds.
