Year 7-10 Debating

Our junior debaters enjoyed the spirit of friendship and competition this week as they came up against Cromer Campus in the Premier's Debating Challenge. Manly's new Year 7 team (Charles Highnam, Maria Margossian, Toby Heesom and Chae-Eun Kim) were tasked with arguing that commercial television should have to show more Australian content. In a spirited debate characterised by solid arguments from both sides, Cromer were successful in persuading the adjudicator that this should not become media policy.

Meanwhile the Year 8 team (Genevieve Bauder, Michael Hawkins, Isabelle Stapf-Giannakis and Max Hamilton) were able to convince the adjudicator that children should not be banned from participating in reality TV shows. In the third debate of the day, the Year 10 team (Eliza Lo Russo, Max Oldham, Jared Li and Max De Vries) argued that we should reserve seats in parliament for Indigenous candidates, with the win also going to Manly.

Our next Year 7/8 debates will be held against Mackellar Campus.

Premier's Sporting Challenge

NBSC Manly Campus has registered to participate in the 2019 NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge. The purpose of the Challenge is to encourage students to participate in sport and physical activity to lead a healthy lifestyle. Year 9 and 10 PASS students will be participating in the Premier's Sporting Challenge this semester.

What is the Premier's Sporting Challenge (PSC) Sport Leadership program?

The PSC Sport Leadership program supports schools in developing leadership opportunities for students through sport and physical activity. The program identifies schools as members of a Sport Leadership Community (SLC).

What are the benefits of the program for schools?

The PSC Sport Leadership Program addresses the well documented benefits of the importance of leading an active, healthy lifestyle and supports the following Department of Education initiatives by addressing the physical, social and cognitive wellbeing of students as part of the wellbeing framework.

Wellbeing Framework

- increasing leadership opportunities for students and establishing connectedness between primary and secondary schools as part of the *Leadership in the Middle School* Program
- strengthening networks within and between communities of schools
- addressing curriculum outcomes of *PDHPE* and *Stage 5 Physical Activity & Sport Studies (PASS)*
- reinforcing the school's values of engagement and inclusion through participation in sport and physical activity
- developing a school culture that promotes health and physical activity for all students.

This Sports Leadership program provides an educational pathway for student leaders with aspirations and interests in sport and physical activity; sport coaching and officiating whilst developing their overall fitness and skill development.

Through their PASS studies students are introduced to the basics of sports coaching, organising and administration through a series of workshops. Students have the option of running and coaching various activities throughout the semester including, coaching Year 7 gala day Teams, and assisting with running the Gala day. Lunchtime sporting competitions; and leading tabloid sports initiatives.

Physical activity is valued for its physical, social and emotional benefits. It also helps young people to develop communication skills, confidence and resilience.

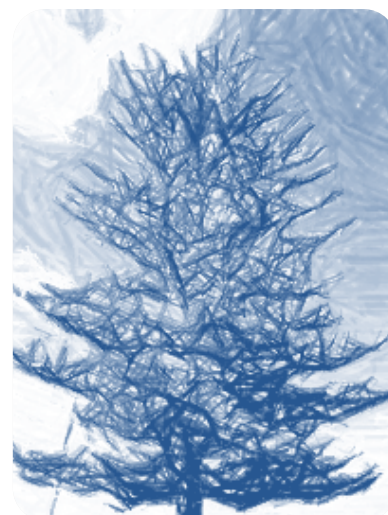
